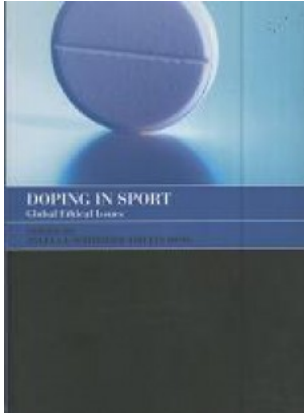

This book considers ethical arguments about performance enhancing drugs in sport in a global context. It examines:
