This book differs fundamentally from other works on approximation theory:

- ? The emphasis is on topics close to numerical algorithms.
- ? Everything is illustrated with Chebfun.
- ? Each chapter is a PUBLISHable Matlab M-file, available online.
- ? The emphasis is on theorems and methods for analytic functions, which appear so often in applications, rather than on functions at the edge of discontinuity with their seductive theoretical challenges.
- ? Original sources are cited rather than textbooks, and each item in the bibliography is accompanied by an editorial comment.
